Here is an Organ update from Barger & Nix. They have created a Dropbox folder for our organ rebuilding and they will be adding photos to that folder as things move forward. At this point, the console is cleaned and the new wood parts are in the design and stain/finish testing stage. The new platform for the pipe cabinet is built and painted, and they are working steadily on the casework that goes below the original organ casework in front.
